Missionary News - Sandra - Nepal

In the past six weeks of lockdown in Nepal many walked long distances to receive food Shubhas had bought in bulk & stored at their centre. 25 people from a blind community came in groups of 5 to receive food, hear the good news about Jesus & re-



ceive prayer. The strict lockdown will continue for another 2wks, although this could change again. Food shops are supposed to officially open for 2 hrs a day very soon. A man walked 4 hrs each way to receive food. A young girl walked 2hrs each way to receive food as her parents are disabled and unable to walk very far. Sarita works as a maid. Due to the current covid situation, her work was severely affected and she was unable to pay rent or buy food. The landlord kicked her out and now she sleeps in a small hut with her children as they have nowhere else to go. She has three children and one of them is handicapped. She used to have to lock her son inside the room when she went to work as she had no other help. She is not able to pay for her other 2 children to go to school because her salary is not enough to support her family. Her husband had cancer and died 5 years ago. Our food relief has brought joy to her family and although it is not much, she is really happy.
